Uniform Assistance Program

Fact Sheet

Concept: One of Scouting's methods of youth development includes wearing a uniform. The Scout uniform makes Scouting visible as a force for good, signifies the Scout's commitment to Scouting ideals and serves as an economic equalizer of all boys.

Background: Recognizing the essential role of the uniform in Scout programs, the Lilly Endowment has offered funds to support a Uniform Assistance program for Scouts who would not otherwise be able to purchase a uniform.

How the Program Works:

- 1) The unit leader certifies the Scout has qualified by:
 - a. Being active in the unit for one month.OR
 - b. Has earned one rank advancement (defined as: Tiger, Bobcat, Wolf, Bear, Webelos, Arrow of Light, Tenderfoot, 2nd Class, 1st Class, Star, Life or Eagle).
- 2) The Scout presents the completed application, with signatures, and his payment of \$20 (or his pledge to pay \$20) to the Scout Service Center.
- 3) When the Scout ends his Scout participation, he may return his shirt, scarf and slide to the Scout Service Center for \$5.

What Uniform Parts Are Included:

- a. Short sleeve shirt (appropriate to program)
- b. Cub Scout Neckerchief (appropriate to grade)
- c. Cub Scout Neckerchief slide (appropriate to grade)
- d. Merit badge sash (Boy Scouts only)
- e. Council shoulder patch
- f. Pack or troop numbers
- g. World Crest
- h. Patrol medallion or den number
- i. Webelos color (if applicable)
- j. Shoulder loops (if applicable)
